**MEXICAN CITIZEN SENTENCED TO 30 MONTHS  
FOR ILLEGALLY RE-ENTERING UNITED STATES**

Madison, Wis. - John W. Vaudreuil, United States Attorney for the Western District of Wisconsin, announced that Juan Manuel Ochoa-Montoya, 45, a citizen of Mexico, was sentenced today by U.S. District Judge Barbara B. Crabb to 30 months in prison, without the possibility of parole, for illegally re-entering the United States after being deported. Ochoa-Montoya pleaded guilty to this charge on July 27, 2010.

Ochoa-Montoya was deported from the United States in 2000 after being convicted of felony burglary in Indiana. Ochoa-Montoya was found in Madison on April 15, 2010, and arrested by immigration officials.

The charge against Ochoa-Montoya was the result of an investigation conducted by the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement Office of Homeland Security Investigations. The prosecution of the case has been handled by Assistant U.S. Attorney Rita M. Rumbelow.
