26 **COUNT 1**

27 **(Possession of Controlled Substances with Intent to Distribute)**

28 On or about May 17, 2021, in Stanwood, Snohomish County, within the Western District of Washington, and elsewhere, the defendant, CHRISTERFER FRICK, did knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute, heroin and fentanyl, substances controlled under Title 21, United States Code, Section 812, Schedule II.

The Grand Jury further alleges that the offense involved 400 grams or more of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of N-phenyl-N-[1-(2-phenylethyl)-4-piperidinyl] propanamide (Fentanyl).

The Grand Jury further alleges that the offense involved one (1) kilogram or more of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of heroin.

All in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1), and 841(b)(1)(A).

ASSET FORFEITURE ALLEGATION

All of the allegations contained in this Indictment are hereby re-alleged and incorporated by reference for the purpose of alleging forfeiture. Upon conviction of the offense alleged in Count 1, the defendant, CHRISTOFER FRICK, shall forfeit to the United States, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853, any property that constitutes or is traceable to proceeds of the offenses, as well as any property that facilitated the offense.

Substitute Assets

If any of the above-described forfeitable property, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant,

1. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
 2. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third party;
 3. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court;
 4. has been substantially diminished in value; or
 5. has been commingled with other property which cannot be divided without difficulty;

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1 it is the intent of the United States, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section
2 853(p), to seek the forfeiture of any other property of the defendant up to the value of the
3 above-described forfeitable property.




