It is stipulated by and between the undersigned parties by their respective attorneys, that:



The parties consent that a Final Judgment in the form hereto attached may be filed and entered by the Court at any time after the expiration of thirty (30) days following the date of filing of this Stipulation without any further notice to any party or other proceedings, either upon the motion of any party or upon the Court's own motion, provided that plaintiff has not withdrawn its consent as hereinafter provided.

2. The plaintiff may withdraw its consent hereto at any time within the said period of thirty (30) days by serving notice thereof upon all other parties hereto and filing said notice with the Court.

3. In the event plaintiff withdraws its consent thereto, this Stipulation shall be of no effect whatever in this or any other proceeding and the making of the Stipulation shall not in any manner prejudice any consenting party in any subsequent proceedings.





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
