It is stipulated by and between the undersigned

the date of filing of this Stipulation without further  
notice to any party hereto or other proceedings, either  
upon the motion of a party hereto or upon the Court's own  
motion, provided that plaintiff has not withdrawn its consent  
as provided herein;

2. The plaintiff may withdraw its consent at any  
time within said period of thirty days by serving notice  
thereof upon the defendant and filing said notice with the  
Court;

3. In the event plaintiff withdraws its consent,  
this Stipulation shall be of no effect whatever in this or  
any other proceeding and the making of this Stipulation shall

not in any manner prejudice defendant in any subsequent proceedings.
