## STIPULATION

- The parties consent that Article VI in the form provided in the Final Judgment attached hereto may be filed and entered by the Court at any time after the expiration of thirty (30) days following the date of filing of this Stipulation without further notice to any party or other proceedings, either upon the motion of any party or upon the Court's own motion; provided that plaintiff has not withdrawn its consent as provided herein;
- The plaintiff may withdraw its consent to such Article at any time within said period of thirty (30) days by serving notice thereof upon the other party hereto and filing said notice with the Court;
- In the event plaintiff withdraws its consent to such Article, this Stipulation shall be of no effect whatever in this or any other proceeding and the making of this Stipulation shall not in any manner prejudice any consenting party in any subsequent proceeding;

Limited shall remain subject to discovery under the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, from all parties to this action, after the entry of said Final Judgment, to the same extent as though defendant Imperial Chemical Industries Limited were still a party defendant in this action, and it shall cease being subject to such discovery only when and as soon as, this action ceases to be pending with respect to defendant Glaxo Group Limited.
