>I will fax you the language MS is presenting to OEMs. Of course we >can't guarantee that every OEM will sign the language as is, but we are >serious about this. AOL must keep this language (and this email) confidential. David pls don't forward this around AOL.

>There are a very very few number of OEMs with preexisting contracts and >those OEMs might not sign the language as i fax to you. Even in these >very few cases, however, the preexisting contracts include language >which covers the same ground but not in such detail. We feel relatively >comfortable that even under the preexisting language, an OEM couldn't >remove icons under the old agreements. In fact, MS recently threatened >to terminate an OEM (which has preexisting language) which tried to >remove icons and the OEM reversed course.
