I wrote you a message last week about a customer supporting an ISP where all Netscape users were locked out while Internet Explorer users accessed the net without problem. The problem was presumed to be use of NT authentication on access control, which was only available on the Internet Explorer browser.

As of a telephone call to the customer today, my evaluation was correct. By specifying basic text on access control rather than by following Microsoft's recommendation, all users could access the IIS server regardless of the browser used.
