The Numbers for Phase 1

NEXTEL-000813

- Current benefit calculations for phase 1 are as follows (2003 2007....as reviewed by business owners):
 - > Total Net Value Gained \$

- > \$ total dollars budgeted/spend for phase 1 (\$ net project dollars)
- \$ M in total dollars of benefits
 - \$ in cost reduction (543 heads currently performing in scope functions can be reduced by 237 heads to = 306 in 2006). This will enable Best-In-Class performance.
 - \$ in avoided costs (659 heads projected in 2006 without NexStep; 659 less 543 current = 116 heads not hired in 2004-2006)
 - \$ in targeted business cases cost savings and \$ in field benefit
- > NPV = \$ (discount rate of 12%)
- ROI = 183% with field benefit






Phase 1 FTEs Over Time
