**NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE WITH TUNNEY ACT REQUIREMENTS**

Plaintiff, United States of America, hereby certifies that it has complied with the provisions of the Antitrust Procedures and Penalties Act, 15 U.S.C. § 16(b)-(d) and states:

1. The proposed Final Judgment and Competitive Impact Statement were filed on June 10, 2016;
2. Pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 16(b), the proposed Final Judgment and Competitive Impact Statement were published in the Federal Register on June 20, 2016, 81 Fed. Reg. 39,957;
3. Pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 16(c), a summary of the terms of the proposed Final Judgment and Competitive Impact Statement were published in *The Washington Post*, a newspaper of general circulation in the District of Columbia, during the period June 16 through 22, 2016;
4. The 60-day comment period specified in 15 U.S.C. § 16(b) commenced on June 22, 2016, and terminated on August 21, 2016;
5. The United States received no comments from members of the public concerning the proposed Final Judgment;
6. Defendants have complied with the requirements of 15 U.S.C. § 16(g);
7. Pursuant to the Stipulation filed on June 10, 2016, and 15 U.S.C. § 16(e), the Court may enter the Final Judgment after it determines that the Judgment serves the public interest;

8. Plaintiff's Competitive Impact Statement demonstrates that the proposed Final Judgment satisfies the public interest standard of 15 U.S.C. § 16(e); and
9. Plaintiff requests that this Court enter the Final Judgment without further hearings and is authorized by counsel for Defendants to state that Defendants join in this request.
