JOINT STATUS REPORT

Pursuant to the Court's directive at the July 14, 2026 Status Conference, the Parties submit the following Joint Status Report. Since the Status Conference, the Parties have worked diligently to address the issues identified by the Court. Given the number of issues the Parties are still conferring over, including issues involving ongoing consultation with the Technical Committee (TC), the Parties jointly and respectfully request that the Court vacate the status conference scheduled for July 23, 2026 and propose that the Parties file a further status report on July 30, 2026.

I. Compelled Testimony from TC Staff

Section VII.C.3.c of the Final Judgment provides that: “No member of the TC shall be required to testify by deposition, in court, or before any other tribunal regarding any matter related to this Final Judgment.” The TC Members have consulted with the TC’s employment counsel to determine proposed language to extend this provision, or a similar provision, to cover TC Staff. On July 22, 2026, after consultation with TC Members, Plaintiffs proposed language to Google for such a provision. The Parties will soon confer regarding the proposal.

II. Google’s Indemnification of TC Staff

Section VII.A.6 of the Final Judgment provides that “Google shall indemnify each TC member and hold them harmless against any losses, claims, damages, liabilities, or expenses arising out of, or in connection with, the performance of the TC’s duties, except to the extent that such liabilities, losses, damages, claims, or expenses result from misfeasance, gross negligence, willful or wanton acts, or bad faith by the TC member.” Pursuant to that provision, Plaintiffs, Google, and the TC Members, in consultation with their counsel, negotiated indemnification agreements that Google and each TC Member executed. The TC Members have since consulted with the TC’s employment counsel regarding extending this provision, or a similar provision, to cover TC Staff. On July 16, 2026, after consultation with TC Members, Plaintiffs proposed that, in addition to Google’s indemnification of TC Members under Section VII.A.6 of the Final Judgment, Google also indemnify all TC Staff. Google has requested clarification from Plaintiffs as to the need for and proposed scope of Plaintiffs’ requested indemnification, and with respect to Plaintiffs’ proposal of insurance coverage as a potential alternative. Plaintiffs have directed these questions to the TC’s employment counsel. The Parties will continue to confer after Plaintiffs receive such information from the TC’s employment counsel.

III. Post-TC Employment Restrictions

Section VII.A.2.c of the Final Judgment provides that no TC Member “may perform any work for Google or any Competitor of Google during the time that they serve on the TC and for one (1) year after ceasing to serve on the TC.” Section VII.A.7.i extends this same prohibition to TC Staff. And the Final Judgment defines “Competitor” as “any provider of or potential entrant in the provision of (i) a General Search Engine (GSE) in the United States, (ii) Search Text Ads in the United States, or (iii) a GenAI Product in the United States.” Final J. § IX.E.

On July 16, 2026, after consultation with the TC Members, Plaintiffs proposed language to guide the practical application of the definition of “Competitor” for purposes of Section VII.A.2.c. Google has made a proposal to Plaintiffs that clarifies the date on which an entity would be assessed for Competitor status for purposes of Section VII.A.2.c. Plaintiffs intend to make a revised proposal to Google concerning the application of Section VII.A.2.c. Once they have done so, the Parties will continue to confer.
