JOINT STATUS REPORT

Pursuant to the Court’s July 23, 2026, Minute Order, the Parties submit the following Joint Status Report. The Parties jointly propose that they file a further status report on August 6, 2026.

I. Compelled Testimony from TC Staff

On July 22, 2026, Plaintiffs proposed to Google a prohibition on compelled testimony from TC Staff. Google responded on July 29 with proposed edits. Plaintiffs have shared Google’s proposed edits with the Technical Committee (“TC”), which is conferring with its employment counsel. The Parties are continuing to confer on this issue, with a call set for tomorrow, July 31, and anticipate presenting their position(s) on a proposed resolution to the Court next week.

II. Google's Indemnification of TC Staff

On July 27, 2026, counsel for Plaintiffs, counsel for Google, and the TC's counsel conferred regarding issues relating to indemnification by Google of TC Staff and related insurance issues. Counsel had a comprehensive discussion and identified several points for further inquiry and discussion regarding the scope, material terms, and mechanisms of such indemnification and related insurance. The TC's counsel is continuing to assess the issues and anticipates following up with the Parties shortly, at which point counsel for Plaintiffs and for Google will review the proposals and confer accordingly.

III. Post-TC Employment Restrictions

Today, following consultation with the TC, Plaintiffs made a revised proposal to Google concerning the application of the post-TC employment restrictions in Section VII.A.2.c of the Final Judgment. Google is reviewing that proposal, and the Parties have a call set for tomorrow, July 31, to confer. The Parties anticipate presenting their position(s) on a proposed resolution to the Court next week.
