ORDER MODIFYING DECREE

This cause coming on to be heard at this term and in this court upon the petition and motion of the United States of America, and all the parties having duly appeared by their attorneys and having consented in open court to the entry of said modification it is,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED:

(1) That the court has jurisdiction of the subject matter and of all parties hereto;

(2) That the decree heretofore entered herein on May 6, 1941, be modified as follows:

The provisions of this decree shall not prohibit the defendants or any of them from entering into or complying with any voluntary allocation plan or agreement authorized and approved under and as provided by Public Law 395 (80th Congress), or the endorsing of, giving notice of, or participating in, any meeting called and

conducted by the Department of Commerce for the purpose of discussing, advising upon, negotiating, or effectuating any such plan or agreement, or the performing of any act or acts requested by the Department of Commerce in writing for the initiating or carrying out of any such plan or agreement.

(3) That each and every of the other terms and provisions of said decree be and remain in full force and effect.
