
This action came on for trial before the Court, Honorable ROBERT W. WARREN

Section 1 of the Sherman Act, 15 U.S.C. 1, and enjoining

engaging in any motion picture split agreements,
in any form and with any person, in any motion
picture exhibition market throughout the
United States.
