MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES TO REOPEN THE CASE

The United States has moved today under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 60(b) to terminate the legacy antitrust judgment in this matter. As the case was closed on the docket on October 23, 1970, with this motion the United States asks the Court to reopen the docket administratively to ready it for an order granting the judgment termination request. *See Gross v. German Found. Indus. Initiative*, 549 F.3d 605, 614 (3d Cir. 2008) (recognizing a litigant's

ability to “move to reopen litigation under Rule 60(b)”). A proposed order reopening the case is attached as Exhibit A.
