25	1. Paragraph 2(A): Add the following sentence:
26	"That part of the Avon Refinery known as the Diablo
27	Terminal may be leased to Gulf International Trading
28	Company."
29	2. Paragraph 2(B): Add the following sentences:
30	"For purposes of this subparagraph, the term 'Oil
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Company' shall not include Phillips. However, if before July 1, 1985, Phillips should by virtue of such default, insolvency or bankruptcy or by operation of law or by action taken to protect a security interest in property mortgaged, pledged or encumbered by TOSCO or a subsidiary thereof in Phillips' favor, acquire an ownership interest in any such properties, then Phillips will notify the Court and plaintiff of such acquisition and thereafter divest such of those properties as the Court may direct on such terms and conditions as the Court may deem appropriate."

3. Except in the preamble, references to the Purchase and Sale Agreement dated June 3, 1975 shall be understood to refer to the Restated Purchase and Sale Agreement dated January 9, 1976, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit A to the Notice of the aforementioned Motion, filed herein January 26, 1976.
