**MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES TO
TERMINATE LEGACY ANTITRUST JUDGMENT**

The United States moves to terminate the Final Judgment in the above-captioned antitrust case pursuant to Rule 60(b) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure. As explained in the accompanying Memorandum of Law in Support of the Motion of the United States to Terminate Legacy Antitrust Judgment, the United States has concluded that because of its age and changed circumstances since its entry, this decades-old judgment no longer serves to protect competition. The United States gave the public notice and the opportunity to comment on its intent to seek termination of the Final Judgment; it received no comments. For these and other reasons explained in the accompanying Memorandum, the United States requests that the Final Judgment be terminated.
