SUMMARY OF REASONS FOR TERMINATING EACH JUDGMENT
(Ordered by Year Judgment Entered)

Case No.: 539

Case Name: United States v. Addyston Pipe & Steel Company, et al.

Year Judgment Entered: 1900

Section of Judgment Retaining Jurisdiction: n/a

Description of Judgment: Defendants enjoined from continuing conspiracy through which defendants held secret auctions to allocate upcoming purchases so that defendants would only sell iron pipe at agreed-upon prices.

Reasons Judgment Should Be Terminated:

- Judgment more than ten years old.
- Judgment terms largely prohibit acts the antitrust laws already prohibit (bid rigging and customer allocation).
- Market conditions likely have changed. In particular the original defendants appear to have merged into one entity so that a conspiracy like the one originally at issue would be impossible.

Case No.: 2554

Case Name: United States v. Retail Liquor Dealers Association of Chattanooga, et al.

Year Judgment Entered: 1957

Section of Judgment Retaining Jurisdiction: Paragraph 11

Description of Judgment: Defendants enjoined from, among other things, agreeing to fix prices; issuing resale price lists; and exchanging price information. Defendants' trade association also dissolved.

Reasons Judgment Should Be Terminated:

- Judgment more than ten years old.
- Most defendants no longer exist or are deceased.

Case No.: 5836

Case Name: United States v. Times Printing Company

Year Judgment Entered: 1970

Section of Judgment Retaining Jurisdiction: Paragraph 12

Description of Judgment: Defendants enjoined from, among other things, operating its newspaper at a loss and operating any newspaper in Chattanooga at a loss if the goal or probable effect of such operation would be to eliminate a competing newspaper in the area.

Reasons Judgment Should be Terminated:

- Judgment more than ten years old.
- Market conditions likely have changed. In particular, the rights and obligations created by the judgment have lapsed.
