



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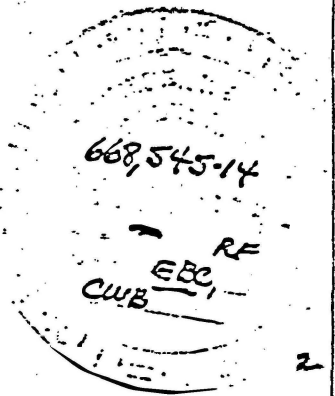

The Court having heard on February 9, 1976 the Motion of Phillips Petroleum Company and The Oil Shale Corporation to amend the Order of Divestiture entered on September 3, 1975 and having considered the papers filed on the Motion,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that such Motion be granted and that the Order of Divestiture entered on September 3, 1975 be amended in the following respects:

1. Paragraph 2(A): Add the following sentence:

"That part of the Avon Refinery known as the Diablo Terminal may be leased to Gulf International Trading Company."

2. Paragraph 2(B): Add the following sentences:

"For purposes of this subparagraph, the term 'Oil
