<u>Description of Judgment</u>: The judgment enjoins the defendant, a trade association of international freight forwarders and customs brokers in the Miami area, from, among other things, fixing prices. The judgment required the defendant to adopt bylaws expelling any member who engages in prohibited conduct, required the defendant to give new members a copy of the judgment, and prohibited the defendant from entering into contracts regarding fees.

Reasons Judgment Should Be Terminated:

- Judgment more than ten years old.
- Judgment terms prohibit acts the antitrust laws already prohibit (price fixing).
