2. That the \$1,000 fine imposed by the Supplemental Judgment on June 15, 1962, be suspended;
3. That the defendant be enjoined from amending or changing Article II(i) and Articles XX and XXI of the By-Laws, Rules and Regulations attached hereto, without prior notice to this Court and the plaintiff and without leave of Court;
4. That Article XXI be made part of the Final Judgment
