

Associated Credit Bureaus, Inc. ("ACB"), as the successor to National Retail Credit Association and Retail Credit Men's National Association, original defendants in this action, having moved this Court for an order terminating the "Decree" entered in this action on October 6, 1933, and the "Order" entered in this action on October 19, 1953, and notice of the motion having been published in The Wall Street Journal, American Banker and Women's Wear Daily, and all interested persons having been given an opportunity to submit comments concerning the proposed termination of the Decree and Order, and plaintiff the United States of America having consented to said motion, and the Court having considered all the papers that have been filed in connection with the motions, and the Court finding that it is in the public interest to terminate the Decree and Order, it is

ORDERED that the Decree entered herein on October 6, 1933,
and the Order entered herein on October 19, 1953, be terminated,
and said Decree and Order shall be of no further force or effect.
