STIPULATION

It is stipulated by and between the undersigned parties, by their respective attorneys, that

1. Defendant Gestetner Corporation will publish at its expense a notice in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A in: (a) two consecutive issues of the national edition of The Wall Street Journal, (b) Office World News, and (c) Office Systems 95; and an Order, in the form attached hereto as Exhibit B, directing such publication, may be filed and entered by the Court forthwith, without further notice to any party or other proceedings.

2. An Order in the form attached hereto as Exhibit C, terminating the Final Judgment entered in this action on September 9, 1968, may be filed and entered by the Court, upon the request of any party or by the Court sua sponte, at any time more than seventy (70) days after the last publication of the notices required by Paragraph 1 of this Stipulation and without further notice to any party or other proceedings, provided that Plaintiff has not withdrawn its consent with respect to the moving party, which it may do at any time before the entry of an order terminating the Final Judgment by filing notice of the withdrawal of its consent with the Court

and serving a copy of said notice upon the moving party.

3. If the Plaintiff withdraws its consent, or if the proposed order terminating the Final Judgment is not entered pursuant to this Stipulation as to the moving party, said Stipulation shall be of no effect whatever with respect to such moving party, the making of it shall be without prejudice to Plaintiff or to such moving party in this or any other proceeding affecting it, and it shall not thereafter be used with respect to such moving party in this or any other action, or for any other purpose.
