The Grand Jury charges:

COUNT I
18 U.S.C. §§ 1512(b)(3) and 2
(Tampering with a Witness, Victim, or an Informant)

On or about and between November 5, 2019 and November 20, 2019, both dates
being approximate and inclusive, in the Central Division of the District of Utah and
elsewhere,

FRANK GENE POWELL and FAYE ANN RENTERIA,

defendants herein, knowingly corruptly persuaded or attempted to corruptly persuade another person, and engaged in misleading conduct toward another person, with intent to hinder, delay, and prevent the communication to a law enforcement officer of information relating to the commission or possible commission of a federal offense, and aided and abetted such conduct, to wit, POWELL and RENTERIA have directly contacted L.N. through written correspondence and phone calls in which they have made misleading statements and have attempted to persuade L.N. to help them avoid prosecution and to withhold information from law enforcement regarding a scheme and artifice to defraud, which is a federal offense under 18 U.S.C. § 1343, among other statutory provisions, all in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1512(b)(3) and 2.
