

FORFEITURE ALLEGATION

The allegations contained in Count 1 of this Information are hereby re-alleged and incorporated by reference for the purpose of alleging forfeitures pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 982(a)(2).

Upon conviction of the offense in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 657, set forth Count 1 of the Information, the defendant,

BRIEGE MARIE GISH,

shall forfeit to the United States pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 982(a)(2), any property, real or personal, which constitutes or is derived from proceeds traceable to the offense(s).

If any of the property described above, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:

- a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third party;
- c. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the court;
- d. has been substantially diminished in value; or
- e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be

divided without difficulty,

the United States of America shall be entitled to forfeiture of substitute property pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p), as incorporated by 18 U.S.C. § 982(b)(1) and 28 U.S.C. § 2461(c).

All pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 982(a)(2) and 28 U.S.C. § 2461(c).
