COUNT ONE

UNLAWFUL DISTRIBUTION OF CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES

On or about August 31, 2019, defendant ANTONIO DEL ROSARIO did knowingly and intentionally distribute and dispense dextroamphetamine, a Schedule II controlled substance, to patient J.P. outside the usual course of professional practice and without a legitimate medical purpose.
