

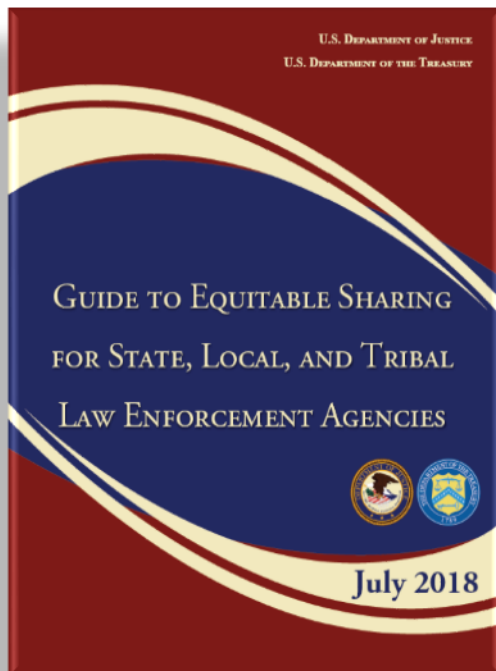

New Joint Guide to Equitable Sharing for State, Local, and Tribal Law Enforcement Agencies

The Department of Justice's Money Laundering and Asset Recovery Section (MLARS) and the Department of the Treasury's Executive Office for Asset Forfeiture (TEOAF) are pleased to announce the release of the new joint [*Guide to Equitable Sharing for State, Local, and Tribal Law Enforcement Agencies*](#) (*Guide*). This joint *Guide* replaces all previous Justice and Treasury Guides and all previous policy directives issued in *Equitable Sharing Wires* (*Wire*).
