

The grand jury charges:


On or about December 21, 2019, within the Southern District of California, defendant PERRY EDWARD DAVIS, did knowingly and intentionally distribute a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of N-phenyl-N-[1-(2-phenylethyl)-4-piperidinyl] propanamide (commonly known as fentanyl), and a detectable amount of cocaine, both Schedule II Controlled Substances, which resulted in the death of another person, to wit, J.C.; all in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C), a felony.
