

COUNT ONE

*Acquiring a Controlled Substance by Misrepresentation, Fraud, Deception, or Subterfuge*  
21 U.S.C. § 843(a)(3)

Beginning as early as April 1, 2020 and continuing until on or about June 17, 2020, in the Southern District of Georgia, Defendant **APRIL FAYETTE** knowingly and intentionally acquired fentanyl, a Schedule II controlled substance, by misrepresentation, fraud, deception, or subterfuge, to wit, that Defendant, while working as a registered nurse, acquired fentanyl that Defendant knew had not been prescribed to Defendant from a hospital that employed Defendant for Defendant's personal use.

All in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 843(a)(3).
