COUNT ONE

**CONSPIRACY TO UNLAWFULLY DISTRIBUTE CONTROLLED
SUBSTANCES**

Beginning on or before October 27, 2015, and continuing until on or about August 21, 2019, defendant MONICA JONES did knowingly and intentionally combine, conspire, confederate, and agree together with other persons known and unknown to the United States Attorney, to unlawfully distribute and dispense Oxycodone and Diazepam, Schedule II and IV controlled substances, in violation of 21 U.S.C. § 841(a)(1).
