**CRIMINAL INFORMATION**

**COUNT ONE**

THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY CHARGES THAT:

Beginning at least in and around November 2016 and continuing thereafter up to and including July 2018, the exact dates being unknown, within the Eastern District of Virginia, and elsewhere, the defendant GEORGE APPIAH did unlawfully, knowingly, and intentionally combine, conspire, confederate, and agree with others both known and unknown, to unlawfully, knowingly, and intentionally distribute controlled substances, to wit, the following:

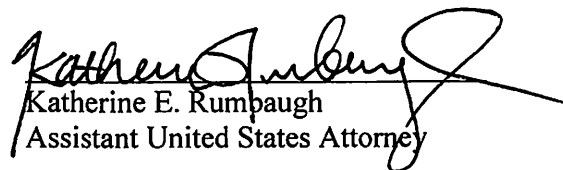
- a. oxycodone, a Schedule II controlled substance;
- b. amphetamine salts, a Schedule II controlled substance;
- c. dextroamphetamine-amphetamine (brand name Adderall), a Schedule II controlled substance;
- d. oxymorphone, a Schedule II controlled substance;
- e. alprazolam (brand name Xanax), a Schedule IV controlled substance;
- f. tramadol, a Schedule IV controlled substance; and
- g. promethazine with codeine, a Schedule V controlled substance;

in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1).
