The United States Attorney charges:

COUNT 1

(Theft of Medical Products)

On or about and between January 1, 2025, and March 14, 2025, in the Western District of Kentucky, Jefferson County, Kentucky, and elsewhere, the defendant, **KRISTINA COOMER**, did knowingly and unlawfully take, carry away, and conceal a pre-retail medical product, using a means and facility of interstate commerce, to wit: **KRISTINA COOMER**, an employee of Victim Pharmacy, a retail pharmacy in the supply chain for Oxycodone, took, carried away, and concealed Oxycodone from Victim Pharmacy, prior to the controlled substances being made available for retail purchase by a consumer.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 670(a)(1), (b)(1), and (c)(3).
