## New Equitable Sharing Agreement and Certification Coming Soon!

The eShare Portal will release an updated Equitable Sharing Agreement and Certification (ESAC) on or about July 15, 2025. The new ESAC aligns with the spending categories in the [Guide to Equitable Sharing for State, Local, and Tribal Law Enforcement Agencies](#) (March 2024). For example, line a is now Law Enforcement Administrative Costs, and Law Enforcement Initiatives that Further Investigations has moved to line j. Note that Overtime is no longer in the salary table and is reported on a separate line. The Tool Tips  that advise users what to report on each line have been updated. Please ensure that you read the Tool Tips for helpful information when completing the ESAC.

### Important Note for June 30 Fiscal Year End

**Agencies:** Do not begin your FY 2025 ESAC until the new ESAC is released on or about July 15. To ensure you are completing the new ESAC, please confirm the OMB date in the top right corner is 5/31/2028. All ESACs in an entered status that have not yet been submitted, regardless of when the ESAC was started, will be deleted from the system when the new ESAC is released. ESACs submitted prior to the new release will be reviewed and processed as normal. If you do not anticipate your ESAC will be completed and submitted prior to July 15, do not start the ESAC.
