## **CRIMINAL INFORMATION**

(Introduction of Adulterated Surgical Gowns in Interstate Commerce With Intent to Defraud and Mislead)
21 U.S.C. §§ 331(a), 333(a)(2)

The United States of America charges:

1. From on or about October 1, 2013, through on or about October 31, 2014, in the Northern District of Texas and elsewhere, the Defendant,

## KIMBERLY-CLARK CORPORATION,

with the intent to defraud and mislead, introduced and caused the introduction into interstate commerce medical devices, namely MicroCool surgical gowns, that were adulterated within the meaning of Title 21, United States Code, Section 351(f)(1)(B), in that Kimberly-Clark Corporation

sold the gowns without a required 510(k) submission that was cleared by the Food and Drug Administration.

All in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 331(a) and 333(a)(2).
