AFFIDAVIT FOR PROBABLE CAUSE

I, Dorsey Kane, Investigator for the Office of the Indiana Attorney General, Medicaid Fraud Control Unit, have good cause to believe that between February 2025 and February 2026, in Allen County, State of Indiana, Mackenzie Deyer ("Deyer") did commit the following crimes:

I.C. 35-43-5-4 Fraud
I.C. 35-43-4-2 Theft

I participated in the investigation of the criminal offenses described in this Affidavit. The statements contained in this Affidavit are founded, in part, on information provided to me through conversations and information from current employees and residents of Evergreen Village, Star Bank, Comerica Bank, Pro Fed Credit Union and DoorDash Inc.

1. I am an Abuse and Neglect Investigator with the Indiana Office of the Attorney General Medicaid Fraud Control Unit. I have served in the Abuse and Neglect Section within the Medicaid Fraud Control Unit since 2007. I am a graduate of the Indiana Law Enforcement Academy and served with the Steuben County Sheriff Department from 1989 to 1997. While at the Sheriff's Department, I served as Patrol Deputy and Detective. I was assigned as the lead investigator on this case after our office received a complaint from the Indiana State Department of Health.
2. Because this affidavit is being submitted for the purpose of filing criminal charges, I have not included all facts that have been revealed during the course of this investigation. I have set forth only the facts necessary to establish the required foundation for probable cause.
3. Mackenzie Deyer was born [REDACTED]. She resides at [REDACTED]. She was employed as a Home Health Aide (HHA) at Evergreen Village, 12523 Auburn Rd. Fort Wayne, Indiana 46845. Deyer was employed from March 20, 2024, to November 25, 2025. Evergreen Village is an assisted living facility.

4. Victim #1, [REDACTED] is a sixty-seven year old resident of Evergreen Village. She is an alert and oriented resident.
5. Victim #2, [REDACTED] is a sixty-six year old resident of Evergreen Village. She is alert and oriented. She has had an ischemic stroke and has some short term memory loss.
6. Victim #3, [REDACTED] was a sixty-seven year old resident of Evergreen Village. [REDACTED] was hospitalized on April 3, 2025, and remained hospitalized until her death on April 9, 2025.
7. On October 17, 2025, I interviewed Victim #1, [REDACTED] On October 17, 2025. She stated in February of 2025, both herself and Deyer were hungry and decided to order Chick-Fil-A from Door Dash. [REDACTED] did not have a Door Dash account, but Deyer had a Door Dash account on her phone and offered to order Door Dash. Deyer took a picture of [REDACTED] Star Bank Mastercard card ending in 2127. Deyer ordered Chick-Fil-A for herself and [REDACTED], with the permission of [REDACTED]. The cost was \$30.23. [REDACTED] advised that was the only time she authorized Deyer to use her bank card. In May of 2025, [REDACTED] discovered DoorDash charges on her banking statements that she did not make or authorize. [REDACTED] confronted Deyer, who said she forgot to remove the bank card from her Door Dash account. A mutual agreement was made that Deyer would reimburse [REDACTED] for the Door Dash charges. [REDACTED] said there was a delay in Deyer paying [REDACTED], so [REDACTED] filed a police report. [REDACTED] couldn't recall the exact dollar amount of the Door Dash charges made by Deyer, but knew it was over \$100 and occurred over the course of several months. [REDACTED] didn't have all the bank statements available at the time of the interview. [REDACTED] said that Deyer did reimburse her \$120 for the unauthorized purchases that [REDACTED] knew about at that time.
8. I interviewed Deyer on October 21, 2025. Deyer advised In February 2025 resident [REDACTED] wanted some food. Deyer has the Door Dash app on her phone. The two decided that Deyer would order food for both of them through DoorDash since [REDACTED] did not have the app. [REDACTED] gave Deyer her Star Debit card information to use for DoorDash. The food was from Chick-fil-A. Dyer stated that she forgot to unlink/delete [REDACTED] debit card from her DoorDash account. Deyer said she didn't make any more DoorDash purchases until May of this year, when she made several DoorDash purchases. Deyer stated she was unaware that the May DoorDash purchases were charged to [REDACTED] debit card and not her own. Deyer was made aware of it when [REDACTED] saw the charges on [REDACTED] bank statement and confronted her. Deyer thought the charges to [REDACTED] debit card totaled \$111.99. An agreement was made between Deyer and [REDACTED] to repay [REDACTED] for the DoorDash charges. Deyer said she repaid [REDACTED] \$120 to cover the May DoorDash charges and Deyer's portion of the February Chick-fil-A charges. Deyer said nothing like this has happened before. During that interview I explained to Deyer that I was going to

subpoena her Door Dash account. I asked her if there was anything else I would find. Deyer stated that I would not find anything else.

9. A Subpoena duces tecum was sent on October 23, 2025, to DoorDash Inc. requesting basic subscriber information, order information and means and source of payment for account belonging to Mackenzie Deyer. On October 31, 2025, I received DoorDash account information, including DoorDash order information, DoorDash subscriber information, DoorDash billing information and DoorDash Certificate of authenticity. I spoke with "Paul" a DoorDash representative. Paul confirmed that if there are multiple bank cards on a subscribers account, the app automatically defaults to the last card used. Basic Subscriber information returned to Deyer. The means of payment had 12 bank cards linked to Deyer's DoorDash account. A subpoena duces tecum was sent to Stripe Inc. because DoorDash uses Stripe Inc. for payment processing. Stripe was able to provide full bank card numbers for 4 for the 12 bank cards linked. Card ending in 2127 Star Financial Bank ([REDACTED]), card ending in 5456 Pro Fed credit union, and card numbers 3250 and 8840 Stride Bank. Subpoena duces tucums were sent to Star Financial Bank, Pro Fed Credit Union and Stride Bank. Stride Bank had no records found for cards ending in 3250 and 8840. Pro Fed Credit Union records came back for card ending in 5456. Card 5456 belonged to [REDACTED] 12523 Auburn Rd. Fort Wayne, In. 46846. That is the address of Evergreen Village.
10. I again went to Deyer's residence on December 15, 2025 and interviewed Deyer. I explained there were numerous cards linked to her DoorDash account. One of the cards belonged to Evergreen resident [REDACTED]. Deyer said her and [REDACTED] ordered food all the time before [REDACTED] died. Deyer said she stopped using [REDACTED] card right before [REDACTED] passed. Prior to that her and [REDACTED] would order DoorDash. [REDACTED] didn't have a Door Dash account so Deyer would use Deyer's DoorDash account. Deyer claimed she was giving [REDACTED] money if she used [REDACTED] bank card. Deyer said she would repay [REDACTED] back the following day and that [REDACTED] kept a ledger. Deyer acknowledged she was aware of the policy against this behavior. I asked who else at Evergreen this is happening to. Deyer said resident [REDACTED] likes to order food. [REDACTED] didn't have a Door Dash app, so they would order food using Deyer's Door Dash app and [REDACTED] card. Deyer denied using [REDACTED] card to order DoorDash if the food wasn't for [REDACTED]. I pointed out that [REDACTED] died on April 9th, yet Door dash orders were placed using [REDACTED] card after [REDACTED] death. I also pointed out that [REDACTED] was deceased and couldn't be paid back. Deyer paused slightly and said she remembered that and it was kind of the same thing as [REDACTED]. Deyer had the card linked to Door dash and didn't take it off. I explained I spoke with DoorDash, and it defaults to the last card used. I pointed out other DoorDash purchases were made using other cards between the times [REDACTED] card was used after [REDACTED] death. Deyer said she knew it wasn't her card, but she didn't know who the card belonged to. Deyer said the only residents' cards

that she had linked to her DoorDash account are [REDACTED], and [REDACTED]. Deyer said she had so many cards linked to her Door Dash account that when she used a card, she didn't know whose card it belonged to. I asked if it wasn't [REDACTED] card she used, how did she know whose card she used belonged to. Deyer said that she didn't know. Deyer said she would determine which card she would use by whichever card would go through. If the card didn't go through, then she would keep trying other cards until one went through. Deyer said she knew they were not her cards when she was using them. She didn't have approval from [REDACTED] to make additional purchases. Deyer claims she did have approval from [REDACTED] who is deceased.

11. I interviewed Victim # 3 [REDACTED], on December 15, 2025. [REDACTED] said that she had allowed Deyer to make Door Dash purchases for her on [REDACTED] card and had it delivered to Evergreen Village. [REDACTED] stated one day they were having something for lunch she didn't like. Deyer offered to order DoorDash. [REDACTED] did not have a DoorDash account, but Deyer did. Deyer ordered Door Dash for the two of them, using [REDACTED] card ending in 7895. [REDACTED] said they ordered food from Door Dash a few times using Deyer's phone and [REDACTED] debit card. The primary places they would get food from was McDonalds, McAlister's and Chick fil-A. [REDACTED] had told Deyer to take her card number off the phone. [REDACTED] stated they only ordered food from Door Dash. Deyer did not have permission or authority to use [REDACTED] debit card at any other time. They ordered food on DoorDash that was delivered to Evergreen Village.

12. A subpoena duces tecum was sent on December 19, 2025, to Comerica Bank for banking statements for Direct Express Mastercard ending in 7895. I received the banking statements for the bank card ending in 7895 belonging to [REDACTED].

13. [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] bank statements were reviewed and compared to Mackenzie Deyer's DoorDash account. The following DoorDash transactions correspond with the bank statements of the above victims. These transactions were made using [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] bank cards.

14. Bank card ending in **2127** – [REDACTED], Star bank Mastercard [REDACTED] authorized 1 DoorDash transaction on February 10, 2025, for \$30.23. She later discovered 7 additional DoorDash charges made on her bank card totaling \$166.48, which she did not authorize. Deyer's home address is [REDACTED]. This information is from DoorDash records.

15. Bank card ending in 7895 – [REDACTED], Direct Express Bank Card. The bank statement was compared to Deyer's DoorDash billing information records and Order information records. Fifty four DoorDash transactions were made using [REDACTED] bank card on Deyer's DoorDash account. DoorDash's Order information records show the date/time orders were created, date/time actual delivery and delivery address, among other things. A review of DoorDash records revealed there were 54 DoorDash transactions made using [REDACTED] card ending in 7895. There were 10 DoorDash deliveries to 12523 Auburn Rd Fort Wayne IN. (Evergreen Village). There were 44 other transactions, where the delivery was to other locations, not Evergreen Village. Totaling \$1,368.39.

On Wednesday February 25, 2026, ██████████ sister tried to make a purchase for her, but the purchase wouldn't go through due to insufficient funds. ██████████ called for her balance and discovered there was only \$40 in her account. Prior to that there had been around \$600 in the account. ██████████ contacted her bank and was told there was \$354 in DoorDash transactions occurring in February 2026. ██████████ did not make these charges, nor did she authorize the DoorDash purchases. ██████████ advised the DoorDash deliveries were to ██████████, which is where Deyer lives. The card ending in 7895 was deactivated on February 25, 2026. I sent subpoenas to Comerica bank for ██████████ bank records for card ending in 7895.

Subpoena was sent to DoorDash requesting Basic Subscriber Information for Mackenzie Deyers' DoorDash account, as well as any delivery order information for January and February 2026 for bank card ending in 7895 linked to Deyer's account.

Mackenzie Deyer was employed at Evergreen Village from March 20, 2024, to November 25, 2025. [REDACTED] has had no contact with Mackenzie Deyer since Deyer's termination.

19. Bank Card ending in 5456 – [REDACTED] Pro-Fed bank card. On April 3, 2025, [REDACTED] was sent to and admitted to Parkview Regional Memorial Hospital. On April 09, 2025, [REDACTED] died at the hospital. From April 3, 2025, to April 9, 2025 (the day [REDACTED] died) there were 17 DoorDash transactions using card ending in 5456. From April 11, 2025, to April 18, 2025, (after [REDACTED] death) there were 19 additional DoorDash transactions made using card ending in 5456. From April 3, 2025, the day [REDACTED] was hospitalized, until April 18, 2025, there were a total of 36 DoorDash transactions for a total of \$1,584.24 using card ending in 5456. Per the interview with Deyer on 12/15/25, Deyer said she stopped using [REDACTED] card "right before she died."
