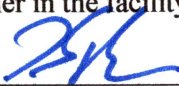

COMPLAINT AND AFFIDAVIT

The Defendant is accused of **Unlawfully Obtaining or Attempting to Obtain a Prescription Drug (Controlled Substance schedule I, II, III)**, in that, **Callie Marie Chamberlin**, on or about 4/7/2026, in the County of Shelby and the State of Iowa, in violation of Iowa Code section(s) 155A.23(1)(a)(1); 155A.24(1)(a); 124.401(1)(c)(9), obtained or attempted to obtain a prescription drug classified as a controlled substance in schedule I, II, or III by engaging in fraud, deceit, misrepresentation, or subterfuge; **to wit:** On 4/7/26, Callie Chamberlin worked as a nurse at Salem Lutheran Home. While working as a nurse, Chamberlin diverted a resident's Fentanyl patch, and took it home. After staff at the facility discovered the Fentanyl patch was missing, Chamberlin attempted to return the Fentanyl patch to the facility. Chamberlin asked another nurse to lie and help cover for her. Chamberlin asked the other nurse to claim that the Fentanyl patch was in a sharps container in the facility the whole time. Fentanyl is a schedule II narcotic. (Class C Felony).

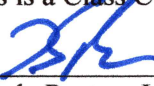

AFFIDAVIT

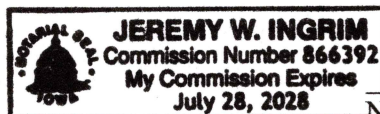
STATE OF IOWA, COUNTY OF POLK
