THE BOONE COUNTY GRAND JURY CHARGES:

COUNT I: Presenting Fraudulent Claims to Defraud the Kentucky Medical Assistance Program over \$1,000, K.R.S. 205.8463, UOR 0020540
Class D felony (1 to 5 years)

Ongoing from March 15, 2022 to December 1, 2023, in Boone County, Kentucky, the above-named Defendant, **ANA VANWAY** committed the offense of Presenting Fraudulent Claims to Defraud the Kentucky Medical Assistance Program ("KMAP") over \$1,000 when she unlawfully caused to be made or presented to an employee or officer of the Cabinet for Health and Family Services false, fictitious, or fraudulent Medicaid claims used in determining rights to a benefit or payment claimed at a value of \$1,000 or more. Ana Vanway wrote prescriptions for herself and her spouse and co-defendant Tyler Vanway and their child when she knew those prescriptions would be billed to KMAP and that she and her family were not eligible to receive KMAP benefits. This resulted in claims presented to KMAP in the amount of at or about \$16,068.94 and KMAP paid at or about \$3,039.06 for these claims.

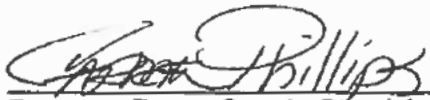
COUNT II: Devising a Scheme or Plan a Scheme or Artifice to Obtain Benefits by Means of False Representation, K.R.S. 194A.505; UOR 00214385
Class D Felony (1 to 5 years)

Ongoing from March 2, 2022 to November 9, 2025, in Boone County, Kentucky, the above-named Defendant, **ANA VANWAY**, committed the offense of Devising a Scheme or Plan a Scheme or Artifice to Obtain Benefits by Means of False Representation from the Kentucky Medical Assistance Program ("KMAP"), when, with the intent to defraud or deceive, she unlawfully received benefits from KMAP for herself and for her husband and co-defendant, Tyler Vanway, and children, when they were ineligible to receive these benefits and/or when, with the intention of promoting or facilitating the commission of the offense, the Defendant solicited, commanded, or engaged in a conspiracy with such other person to commit the offense and/or aided, counseled, or attempted to aid such other person in planning or committing the offense. The benefits Ana Vanway and her family received from KMAP between March 2, 2022 and November 9, 2025 were billed in the amount of at or about \$121,825.92 and KMAP paid at or about \$26,869.73 for those benefits.

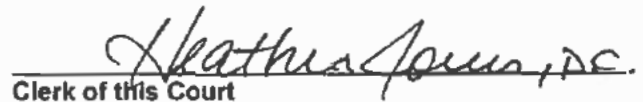

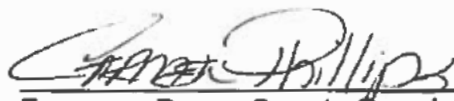
