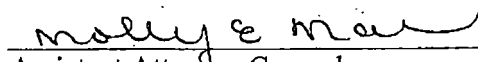

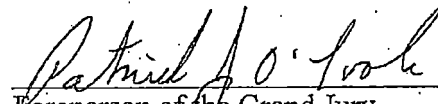
THE STATEWIDE JURORS for the said Commonwealth on their oath present, that:

on divers dates between June 1, 2020 to January 1, 2026, at New Bedford, in the County of Bristol, actuated by a continuing criminal intent and pursuant to a single scheme, did steal, or with intent to defraud, obtain by false pretences, the property of another in a value exceeding one thousand two hundred dollars, in violation of the provisions of section 30 of Chapter 266 of the General Laws of Massachusetts, to wit: money belonging to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Executive Office of Health and Human Services, MassHealth, used to pay for personal care attendant services from her brother that were never provided.

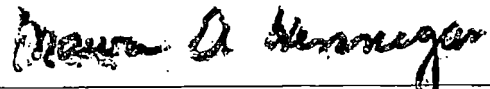
