LINDA JENKINS did on or about and between May 15, 2024 and June 20, 2024 in Hinds County, Mississippi did unlawfully, willfully, and feloniously make, present, and cause to be made and presented false, fictitious, or fraudulent claims for Medicaid benefits for service dates on or about May 15, 2024 until on or about June 20, 2024, within the jurisdiction of this Court pursuant to §43-13-213, in that the defendant represented that she had provided medical care to patients/Medicaid beneficiaries knowing that at the time the claims were submitted that the care was not provided to the patients/Medicaid beneficiaries, contrary to and in violation of §43-13-213 of the Mississippi code of 1972, as amended, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Mississippi.
