FALSE OR FRAUDULENT CLAIM FOR MEDICAID BENEFITS (5 Counts)**

Section 43-13-213, Miss. Code of 1972, as amended

THE GRAND JURORS of the State of Mississippi, taken from the body of the good and lawful citizens of Hinds County, duly elected, summoned, empaneled, sworn and charged to inquire in and for the aforesaid county, at the term aforesaid, in the name and by the authority of the State of Mississippi, upon their oaths present that:

COUNT I

On or about and during a time period between September 1, 2023 and March 3, 2025, in Washington County, Mississippi, SHEILA BONEY COLLINS, did unlawfully, willfully, and feloniously make, present, and cause to be made and presented false, fictitious, or fraudulent claims for Medicaid benefits for service dates between September 1, 2023 and March 3, 2025, within the jurisdiction of this Court pursuant to §43-13-213, in that the defendant represented that she provided adult day care services to Medicaid beneficiaries knowing that at the time the claims were submitted the services were not provided to the Medicaid beneficiaries, contrary to and in violation of §43-13-213 of the *Mississippi Code of 1972, Annotated*, as amended, contrary to the statute in such cases made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Mississippi.

COUNT II

On or about and during a time period between March 4, 2025 and March 19, 2025, in Washington County, Mississippi, SHEILA BONEY COLLINS, did unlawfully, willfully, and feloniously make, present, and cause to be made and presented false, fictitious, or fraudulent claims for Medicaid benefits for service dates between March 4, 2025 and March 19, 2025, within the jurisdiction of this Court pursuant to §43-13-213, in that the defendant represented that she provided adult day care services to Medicaid beneficiaries knowing that at the time the claims were submitted the services were not provided to the Medicaid beneficiaries, contrary to and in violation of §43-13-213 of the *Mississippi Code of 1972, Annotated*, as amended, contrary to the statute in such cases made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Mississippi.

COUNT III

On or about and during a time period between May 22, 2025 and May 30, 2025, in Washington County, Mississippi, SHEILA BONEY COLLINS, did unlawfully, willfully, and

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feloniously make, present, and cause to be made and presented false, fictitious, or fraudulent claims for Medicaid benefits for service dates between May 22, 2025 and May 30, 2025, within the jurisdiction of this Court pursuant to §43-13-213, in that the defendant represented that she provided adult day care services to Medicaid beneficiaries knowing that at the time the claims were submitted the services were not provided to the Medicaid beneficiaries, contrary to and in violation of §43-13-213 of the *Mississippi Code of 1972, Annotated*, as amended, contrary to the statute in such cases made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Mississippi.

COUNT IV

On or about and during a time period between June 3, 2025 and June 13, 2025, in Washington County, Mississippi, SHEILA BONEY COLLINS, did unlawfully, willfully, and feloniously make, present, and cause to be made and presented false, fictitious, or fraudulent claims for Medicaid benefits for service dates between June 3, 2025 and June 13, 2025, within the jurisdiction of this Court pursuant to §43-13-213, in that the defendant represented that she provided adult day care services to Medicaid beneficiaries knowing that at the time the claims were submitted the services were not provided to the Medicaid beneficiaries, contrary to and in violation of §43-13-213 of the *Mississippi Code of 1972, Annotated*, as amended, contrary to the statute in such cases made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Mississippi.

COUNT V

On or about July 3, 2025, in Washington County, Mississippi, SHEILA BONEY COLLINS, did unlawfully, willfully, and feloniously make, present, and cause to be made and presented false, fictitious, or fraudulent claims for Medicaid benefits for service date July 3, 2025, within the jurisdiction of this Court pursuant to §43-13-213, in that the defendant represented that she provided adult day care services to Medicaid beneficiaries knowing that at the time the claims were submitted the services were not provided to the Medicaid beneficiaries, contrary to and in violation of §43-13-213 of the *Mississippi Code of 1972, Annotated*, as amended, contrary to the statute in such cases made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Mississippi.

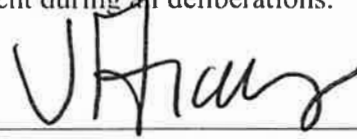
