The Grand Jurors of and for the State of New Jersey, upon their oaths, present that:

COUNT ONE

(Health Care Claims Fraud - Second Degree)

MICHAEL SERVON

between on or about December 10, 2024, and on or about January 10, 2025, at the Township of Toms River, in the County of Ocean, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did knowingly make or cause to be made, a false, fictitious, fraudulent, or misleading statement of material fact in, or omitted a material fact from, or caused a material fact to be omitted from, any record, bill, claim, or other document, in writing, electronically or in any other form, that he attempted to submit, submitted, caused to be submitted, or attempted to cause to be submitted for payment or reimbursement for health care services, that is, MICHAEL SERVON knowingly submitted five or more fraudulent timesheets to the New Jersey Medical Assistance and Health Services Program, through Public Partnerships, LLC, for reimbursement for health care services purportedly rendered to Medicaid beneficiary M.S. and to obtain a pecuniary benefit of \$1,000 or more, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:21-4.3c, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT TWO

(Medicaid Fraud - Third Degree)

MICHAEL SERVON

between on or about December 10, 2024, and on or about January 10, 2025, at the Township of Toms River, in the County of Ocean, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, acting with an intent to fraudulently secure payments not authorized under the New Jersey Medical Assistance and Health Services Act, N.J.S.A. 30:4D-1 et seq., and payments in a greater amount than that which is authorized under the Act, knowingly and willfully did make or cause to be made false statements and representations of material fact in documents necessary to apply for and receive medical assistance payments under the Act, that is, MICHAEL SERVON caused to be submitted fraudulent timesheets to the New Jersey Medical Assistance and Health Services Program, through Public Partnerships, LLC, for reimbursement for health care services purportedly rendered to Medicaid beneficiary M.S., contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 30:4D-17b(1), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT THREE

(Theft by Deception - Third Degree)

MICHAEL SERVON

between on or about December 10, 2024, and on or about January 10, 2025, at the Township of Toms River, in the County of Ocean, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, purposely did obtain payment from the New Jersey Medical Assistance and Health Services Program, through Public Partnerships, LLC, having a value of more than \$500, but less than \$75,000, by deception, that is, by creating or reinforcing the false impression to Public Partnership, LLC that he provided health care services to Medicaid beneficiary M.S., when he, in fact, did not, and receiving payments for services not rendered, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:20-4, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.
