The Lane County District Attorney on oath accuses the defendant of the following offense(s):

COUNT 1: MAKING A FALSE CLAIM FOR HEALTH CARE PAYMENT
ORS 165.692, Class C Felony

COUNT 2: MAKING A FALSE CLAIM FOR HEALTH CARE PAYMENT

COUNT 3: THEFT IN THE FIRST DEGREE

COUNT 5: AGGRAVATED IDENTITY THEFT
ORS 165.803, Class B Felony

The defendant committed the offense(s) as follows:

COUNT 1: MAKING A FALSE CLAIM FOR HEALTH CARE PAYMENT

The defendant, Amanda Joy Booth Thorne, on, about or between September 1, 2024, and September 30th, 2024, in Lane County, Oregon, did unlawfully, knowingly, make or cause to be made a claim for health care payment that contained a false statement or false representation of a material fact in order to receive a health care payment, to wit: confirmation number: 41HP7XCRZZ1.

COUNT 2: MAKING A FALSE CLAIM FOR HEALTH CARE PAYMENT

The defendant, Amanda Joy Booth Thorne, on, about or between April 1, 2025, and April 30th, 2025, in Lane County, Oregon, did unlawfully, knowingly, make or cause to be made a claim for health care payment that contained a false statement or false representation of a material fact in order to receive a health care payment, to wit: voucher number: 01358692.

COUNT 3: THEFT IN THE FIRST DEGREE

The defendant, Amanda Joy Booth Thorne, on, about or between September 1, 2024, and September 30th, 2024, in Lane County, Oregon, did unlawfully and knowingly commit theft of money, of the total value of one thousand dollars or more, the property of the State of Oregon;

COUNT 4: THEFT IN THE FIRST DEGREE

The defendant, Amanda Joy Booth Thorne, on, about or between April 1, 2025, and April 30th, 2025, in Lane County, Oregon, did unlawfully and knowingly commit theft of money, of the total value of one thousand dollars or more, the property of the State of Oregon;

COUNT 5: AGGRAVATED IDENTITY THEFT

The defendant, Amanda Joy Booth Thorne, on, about or between April 2, 2025 and August 19, 2025, in Lane County, Oregon, did unlawfully and intentionally, with the intent to deceive or defraud, convert to defendant's own use personal identification of Lane County, to wit: personal use of Lane County Procurement Card issued for Developmental Disabilities Services client purchases, violating ORS 165.800 in 10 or more separate incidents within a 180-day period.

The offenses are joined in this single charging instrument because they are of the same or similar character.

The State further alleges that the above charges are part of a common scheme or plan.

The State further alleges that the above charges are separate and distinct actions and contrary to statute and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oregon.

I certify, under the penalties described in ORS 133.992, that I have sufficient grounds to believe, and do believe, that the defendant committed the offense(s) specified above.
