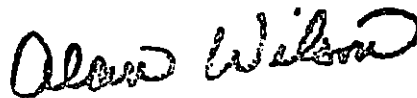
INDICTMENT

At a Court of General Sessions, convened on June 16, 2026, the Grand Jurors of Fairfield County present upon their oath:

Financial Transaction Card Fraud value more than \$500 in six month period

That on or about April 10, 2026, through April 20, 2026, Leslie Ann Williams did, in Fairfield County, commit the crime of Financial Transaction Card Fraud value more than five hundred (\$500) in six month period. More specifically, Leslie Ann Williams, with the intent to defraud the issuer or person, did obtain money, goods, services or anything else of value by representing, without consent of the cardholder, N.G., that she had permission to use the card. The value of money, goods or services obtained was more than five hundred (\$500) dollars in a six month period. This is in violation of Section 16-14-0060(a), South Carolina Code of Laws, 1976 as amended.

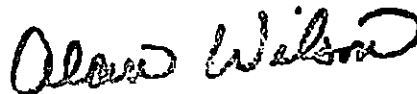
INDICTMENT

At a Court of General Sessions, convened on June 16, 2026, the Grand Jurors of Fairfield County present upon their oath:

Exploitation of a Vulnerable Adult

That on or about April 10, 2026, through April 20, 2026, Leslie Ann Williams did, in Fairfield County, knowingly and willfully make unlawful, unauthorized, or improper use of the funds or assets of a vulnerable adult (N.G.) for the profit or advantage of Leslie Ann Williams or another person. At all times relevant, N.G. was a resident of a skilled nursing facility in Fairfield, SC and classified as a "Vulnerable Adult" under South Carolina Law. This is a violation of 43-35-0085(D) of the South Carolina Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.

Against the peace and dignity of the State, and contrary to the statute in such case made and provided.

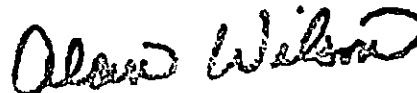
INDICTMENT

At a Court of General Sessions, convened on June 16, 2026, the Grand Jurors of Fairfield County present upon their oath:

Federally Chartered or Insured Financial Institution Crime

That on or about April 10, 2026, through April 20, 2026, Leslie Ann Williams did, in Fairfield County, commit the criminal offense of Federally Chartered or Insured Financial Institution Crime. More specifically, Leslie Ann Williams, did knowingly execute a scheme or artifice to obtain monies, funds, credits, assets, securities, or other property owned by or under control of Republic Bank, a federal chartered or insured financial institution, by means of false or fraudulent pretenses, representations or promises. This is in violation of Section 34-03-0110(A), South Carolina Code of Laws, 1976 as amended.
