Count 1: Theft In the First Degree
RCW 9A.56.030(1)(a)

Count 2: Medicaid False Statement
RCW 74.09.230(1)

I, NICHOLAS W. BROWN, Attorney General for the State of Washington, with the concurrence of Thurston County Prosecuting Attorney JON TUNHEIM pursuant to RCW 43.10.232, through Assistant Attorney General NICK CARTER, do accuse LINA ROCIO PARADA of the crime of THEFT IN THE FIRST DEGREE (CLASS B FELONY) and MEDICAID FALSE STATEMENT (UNRANKED CLASS C FELONY), committed as follows:

COUNT 1 – THEFT IN THE FIRST DEGREE

That the defendant, LINA ROCIO PARADA, in the county of Thurston, State of Washington, on, about, or between August 27, 2024 to May 31, 2025, by color or aid of deception, obtained control over the property or services of another or the value thereof, with intent to deprive the other person of the property or services, to wit: Medicaid funds, of an

1 aggregate value exceeding \$5,000, obtained by a series of transactions which are part of a
2 criminal episode or a common scheme or plan;

3 Contrary to RCW 9A.56.020(1)(a)(b) and RCW 9A.56.030(1)(a), and against the peace
4 and dignity of the State of Washington.

5 **COUNT 2 – MEDICAID FALSE STATEMENT**

6 That the defendant, LINA ROCIO PARADA, in the county of Thurston, State of
7 Washington, on, about, or between August 27, 2024 to May 31, 2025, knowingly made or caused
8 to be made any false statement or representation of a material fact in any application for any
9 payment under any medical care program authorized under RCW 74.09; to wit: related to
10 payment claims for patient A.K.;

11 Contrary to RCW 74.09.230(1), and against the peace and dignity of the State of
12 Washington.
