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On September 26, 2013, Plaintiff United States of America filed a complaint against Defendant Plaza Home Mortgage, Inc., alleging claims for violations of the Fair Housing Act, 42 U.S.C. § 3601 *et seq.*, and the Equal Credit Opportunity Act, 15 U.S.C. § 1691 *et seq.* (Doc. No. 1.) On October 1, 2013, the Court granted the parties' joint motion for a Consent Order and entered a Consent Order in the action between Plaintiff and Defendant. (Doc. No. 8.) The consent order was originally scheduled to terminate on October 1, 2016. (Id. at 18.)

On September 28, 2016, the parties filed a joint motion for an extension of the Consent Order. (Doc. No. 11.) On September 29, 2016, the Court granted the parties' joint motion and extended the termination date of the Consent Order to November 1, 2016. (Doc. No. 12.)

1 On October 28, 2016, the parties filed a second joint motion for an extension of
2 the Consent Order. (Doc. No. 13.) In the motion, the parties explain that they need an
3 additional month to complete certain requirements set forth in the Consent Order. (Id.)
4 Accordingly, for good cause shown, the Court grants the joint motion for extension of
5 time. The Consent Order will now terminate on **December 1, 2016**.
