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18 On September 26, 2013, Plaintiff United States of America filed a complaint
19 against Defendant Plaza Home Mortgage, Inc., alleging claims for violations of the Fair
20 Housing Act, 42 U.S.C. § 3601 *et seq.*, and the Equal Credit Opportunity Act, 15 U.S.C.
21 § 1691 *et seq.* (Doc. No. 1.) On October 1, 2013, the Court granted the parties' joint
22 motion for a Consent Order and entered a Consent Order in the action between Plaintiff
23 and Defendant. (Doc. No. 8.) The consent order is currently scheduled to terminate on
24 October 1, 2016. (*Id.* at 18.)

25 On September 28, 2016, the parties filed a joint motion for extension of the
26 Consent Order. (Doc. No. 11.) In the motion, the parties explain that they need an
27 additional month to complete certain requirements set forth in the Consent Order. (*Id.*)
28 Accordingly, for good cause shown, the Court grants the joint motion for extension of

1 time. The Consent Order will not terminate on **November 1, 2016**.
