

**ADDENDUM TO THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA AND THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS, REHABILITATION, AND REENTRY UNDER THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT**

**DJ No. 204-8-265**

1. The parties to this Addendum to the Settlement Agreement are the United States of America and the Arizona Department of Corrections, Rehabilitation, and Reentry (ADCRR).
2. ADCRR is the state department responsible for operating Arizona's prison system. ADCRR is headquartered in Phoenix, Arizona. The State of Arizona and ADCRR are "public entities" subject to Title II of the ADA and its implementing regulation. 42 U.S.C. § 12131(1); 28 C.F.R. § 35.104.
3. The United States and ADCRR entered into a Settlement Agreement (Agreement) to resolve the United States' investigation, DJ No. 204-8-265, on November 16, 2023, and that agreement is set to terminate on November 16, 2026, three years after the effective date.
4. Given the request by ADCRR and actions it has taken to comply with the Agreement, the United States and ADCRR have agreed to terminate the Agreement in advance of the set termination date. The Parties agree that early termination is in their best interests and the public interest, both to save the United States the costs of monitoring the Agreement, and to save ADCRR the costs of continued reporting under the Agreement.
5. The Parties hereby modify the Agreement to terminate on January 27, 2026.
6. This Addendum does not affect ADCRR's continuing responsibility to comply with the ADA.
7. The persons signing for ADCRR and the United States each represent they are authorized to bind ADCRR and the United States to this Addendum.
8. This Agreement may be executed in counterparts.
