SUPERSEDING INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury in and for the District of New Jersey, sitting at Camden,

charges:

<u>COUNT ONE</u> (Conspiracy to Distribute Controlled Substances)

Between at least in or about July 2020 and on or about July 14, 2021, in

Camden and Salem Counties, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, the defendants,

GLENN LONG, a/k/a "Bless," a/k/a "Max,"

a/k/a "Bless," a/k/a "Max," KEVIN SALMON, SALEEM SMITH, SAVON SKIPWITH, and JOHN MUNSON,

knowingly and intentionally conspired and agreed with each other and others to distribute and possess with intent to distribute the following: (a) 50 grams or more of methamphetamine, its salts, isomers, and salts of its isomers, and 500 grams or more of a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of .

methamphetamine, its salts, isomers, and salts of its isomers, a Schedule II controlled substance; and (b) 400 grams or more of a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of N-phenyl-N- [1- (2-phenylethyl)-4piperidinyl] propenamide ("fentanyl"), a Schedule II controlled substance, contrary to Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(A).

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846.

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<u>COUNT TWO</u>

(Distribution and Possession with Intent to Distribute Controlled Substances) On or about February 16, 2021, in Camden County, in the District of

New Jersey and elsewhere, the defendants,

GLENN LONG, a/k/a "Bless," a/k/a "Max," and KEVIN SALMON,

knowingly and intentionally distributed and possessed with intent to distribute at least 50 grams of methamphetamine, its salts, isomers, and salts of its isomers, a Schedule II controlled substance.

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(A) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

<u>COUNT THREE</u> (Possession with Intent to Distribute Controlled Substances)

On or about December 2, 2020, in Camden County, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, the defendant,

JOHN MUNSON,

knowingly and intentionally possessed with intent to distribute at least 5 grams of methamphetamine, its salts, isomers, and salts of its isomers, a Schedule II controlled substance.

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(B).

<u>COUNTS FOUR THROUGH SEVEN</u> (Use of a Telephone to Further a Drug Offense)

On or about the dates and at or about the times set forth below, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, the defendants set forth below knowingly and intentionally used, and caused to be used, a communication facility, that is, a telephone, in committing, causing and facilitating the commission of any act constituting a felony drug offense, including the conspiracy to distribute and possess with intent to distribute methamphetamine and fentanyl as charged in Count One of this Indictment; in attempting to possess methamphetamine and fentanyl with the intent to distribute; and the distribution and possession with intent to distribute methamphetamine and fentanyl, all of which are felony offenses under Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(l) and 846:

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 843(b) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

<u>COUNT EIGHT</u>

(Possession of a Firearm in Relation to a Drug Trafficking Crime)

On or about March 4, 2021, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, the defendant,

KEVIN SALMON,

during and in relation to a drug trafficking crime for which he may be prosecuted in a court of the United States, that is, conspiracy to distribute controlled substances as charged in Count One of this Indictment, did knowingly possess a firearm in furtherance of such crime.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(c)(1)(A).

FORFEITURE ALLEGATION AS TO COUNTS ONE THROUGH SEVEN

Upon conviction of the offenses alleged in Counts One through Seven of this Indictment, the defendants, GLENN LONG, a/k/a "Bless," a/k/a "Max," KEVIN SALMON, SALEEM SMITH, SAVON SKIPWITH, and JOHN MUNSON shall forfeit to the United States, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853, any and all property constituting or derived from any proceeds the defendant obtained directly or indirectly as a result of the offenses charged in this Indictment, and any and all property used or intended to be used in any manner or part to commit and to facilitate the commission of such offenses.

FORFEITURE ALLEGATION AS TO COUNT EIGHT

Upon conviction of the offenses alleged in Count Eight of this Indictment, the defendant, KEVIN SALMON, shall forfeit to the United States, pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d)(l) and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), any firearms and ammunition involved in or used in the commission of the offense, including, but not limited to, a Taurus 62C 9mm caliber pistol, bearing serial number TLP18095; a black/tan firearm with a Polymer 80 Inc. frame, bearing no serial number; and approximately 25 rounds of 9mm ammunition.

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SUBSTITUTE ASSETS PROVISION (Applicable to all Forfeiture Allegations)

If any of the above forfeitable property, as a result of any act or omission or omission of the defendant:

- (a) cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- (b) has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third person;
- (c) has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court;
- (d) has been substantially diminished in value; or
- (e) has been commingled with other property which cannot be subdivided without difficulty;

the United States intends, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p), as incorporated by Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), to seek forfeiture of any other property of the defendant up to the value of the above described forfeitable property.
