defendant herein, did knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance, namely, a quantity of a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of fentanyl (N-phenyl-N- [1- ( 2-phenylethyl ) -4-piperidinyl] propanamide), a Schedule II Controlled Substance; a quantity of a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of heroin, a Schedule I Controlled Substance; a quantity of a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine base, a Schedule II Controlled Substance; a quantity of a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine, a Schedule II Controlled Substance; and a quantity of a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of marijuana, a Schedule I Controlled Substance;

#### **COUNT SEVEN**

The SPECIAL OCTOBER 2022 GRAND JURY further charges:

On or about March 28, 2023, at Mr. Prospect, in the Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division,

defendant herein, did knowingly possess a firearm, namely, (i) a loaded AR-15 A4 rifle, bearing no serial number; (ii) a loaded Glock 19 pistol bearing serial number BGYY185; (iii) a loaded Glock 27 pistol bearing serial number BNTF199; and (iv) a loaded Glock 19X pistol bearing serial number AFBP094, in furtherance of a drug trafficking crime for which defendant may be prosecuted in a court of the United States, namely, possession with intent to distribute a controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1), as charged in Count Six of this Indictment;

#### FORFEITURE ALLEGATION

The SPECIAL OCTOBER 2022 GRAND JURY further alleges:

- 1. Upon conviction of an offense in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841; or Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(c), as set forth in this Indictment, defendant shall forfeit to the United States of America any property used, and intended to be used, in any manner and part, to commit and to facilitate commission of the offense, as provided in Title 21, United States Code, Section 853; Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d)(1); and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c).
  - 2. The property to be forfeited includes, but is not limited to:
- a. An AR15 rifle, bearing no serial number, .556 caliber magazine, and assorted ammunition;
- b. A Glock 19 pistol, bearing serial number BGYY185, magazine, and assorted ammunition;
- c. A Glock 27 pistol, bearing serial number BNTF199, magazine, and assorted ammunition;
- d. A Glock 19X pistol, bearing serial number AFBP094, magazine, and assorted ammunition;
  - e. Assorted ammunition and magazines; and
- f. Approximately \$9,222 in United States currency seized by law enforcement on or about March 28, 2022.

g. If any of the property described above, as a result of any act or

omission by a defendant: cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence; has

been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third party; has been placed beyond

the jurisdiction of the Court; has been substantially diminished in value; or has been

commingled with other property which cannot be divided without difficulty, the

United States of America shall be entitled to forfeiture of substitute property, as

provided in Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p).
