POST-HEARING ORDER—ORDER REVISING POST-HEARING BRIEFING SCHEDULE

This case arises under the employment discrimination provisions of the Immigration and Nationality Act (INA), as amended by the Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986, 8 U.S.C. § 1324b. On September 13–15, 2023, the Court held an in-person hearing in the above-captioned case pursuant to 28 C.F.R. § 68.39.<sup>1</sup> Following receipt of post-hearing evidence on damages, the Court closed the record on November 21, 2023. Order Closing Record 2.

On April 15, 2024, the Court issued an order setting the parties’ post-hearing briefing schedule. The following day, (April 16, 2024) Complainant filed a “Laymans Response to Courts Post-Hearing Brief.”

“The Administrative Law Judge shall enter the final order within sixty (60) days after receipt of the hearing transcript or of post-hearing briefs . . . if any, by the Administrative Law Judge.” 28 C.F.R. § 68.52(b).
