ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO SUBSTITUTE COUNSEL

This case arises under the employer sanctions provisions of the Immigration and Nationality Act (INA), as amended, 8 U.S.C. § 1324a.

On October 31, 2024, Complainant filed a Notice of Appearance and Motion for Substitution, seeking substitution of Omiga Cape, naming Christopher Ford as Complainant’s counsel of record.

OCAHO’s Rules of Practice and Procedure provide that “[w]ithdrawal or substitution of an attorney or representative may be permitted by the Administrative Law Judge upon written motion.” 28 C.F.R. § 68.33(g). Complainant has satisfied the regulatory requirement to substitute counsel. The Motion is GRANTED.
